Commissioner Hospador moved to increase non-exempt employee wages and wage rates by five (5) percent to the nearest quarter (\$0.25) per hour, effective January 2022. Commissioner Anderson seconded. Hearing 3 aye votes and 0 nay votes the motion passes.
