RESOLUTION 2022-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE
HARTSTENE POINTE WATER-SEWER DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS
ADOPTING THE 2023 BUDGET

WHEREAS, Hartstene Pointe Water-Sewer District is a special purpose district, governed by Title 57 of the Revised Code of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the District Commissioners held a public hearing on the proposed 2023 Budget on November 10, 2022 and heard testimony at said hearing, including testimony received during public hearing period prior to November 10, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Hartstene Pointe Water-Sewer District provided public notice of its intent to adopt a 2023 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the District Commissioners determined the proposed 2023 Budget included expenditure limitations to allow prudent operation of the water, waste water collection, and waste water treatment systems, payment on the District's annual debt service, and funding for scheduled capital outlay projects; and

WHEREAS, the estimated revenues of the District in 2023 plus the estimated 2023 starting fund balance are adequate to fund 2022 expenditures;

THEREFORE, The Board of Commissioners of the Hartstene Pointe Water-Sewer District hereby resolves:

To adopt the enclosed Budget for the period of January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 for the Hartstene Pointe Water-Sewer District.

ADOPTED by the District Board of Commissioners at its scheduled meeting on November 17, 2022.
