General Manager's Report December 22, 2016

Water

- 1. Repaired a leak at the meter box at 436 PDE, cracked female adapter on the incoming side of the meter.
- 2. Saturday December 17, Well 1drawing air had to throttle the flows back.
- 3. Took annual nitrate samples at both wells, distribution system lead and copper samples, Volatile Organic, Inorganic samples for Well 2, and radium 228, Gross Alpha at Well 1.

Drinking Water Treatment Upgrade

1. Sare Electric onsite Thursday 12-15 to drop off equipment and supplies. They began excavation for the new main electrical Friday 12-16. The control wires for Well 2 were hit during the excavation. The main breaker for the well pump power failed when shut off for repairs, we had to put well 1 online for the weekend until the main disconnect was replaced. Well 2 was put back online Monday. We are still having well control issues at Well 2.

Well 1 Replacement

1. Nothing to report.

Sewer Collection

- 1. December 22, Sewer line issue at 111 Liberty reported. Owner will have Roto Rooter out to investigate and clear.
- 2. December 22, 112 Liberty making connection to sewer on an existing RV connection. Discovered an issue at the original connection that needs to be resolved by the contractor.
- 3. December 22, Grundfos pumps delivered the rebuilt spare pump for lift station 8.

Waste Water Treatment

- 1. The influent flows for December have been within the permit limits as of today. The fecal counts have been good and we haven't had any problems with the processes.
- 2. December 22, Grundfos pumps delivered the rebuilt effluent pump spare.

Customer Service

1. Turn off water at 744 Promontory at customers request due to the freezing weather.
